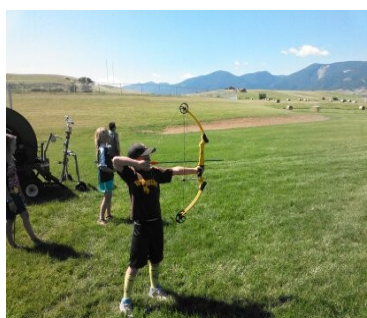
### *Battle Under the Big Horns*
