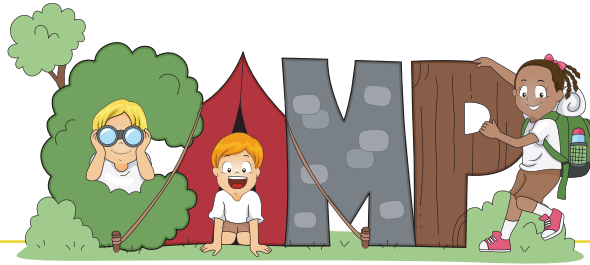
## Mission Statement:
